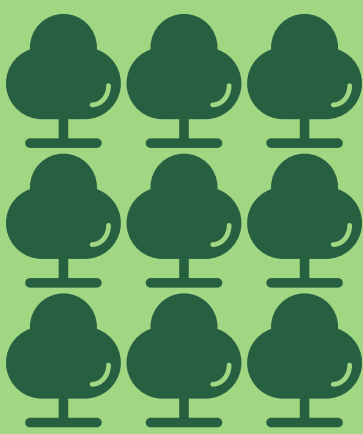


Agroforestry Belt

Agroforestry is a land use system in which woody plants are combined with more arable crops. The agroforestry belt mimicked the forest's natural hierarchy, protected against soil erosion, promoted biomass production, and limited deforestation.



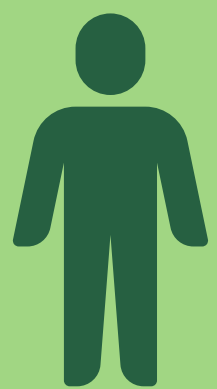
